



## **Apply for an STP Student Travel Award to Attend the 2012 STP Annual Meeting**

*Boston ~ June 24-28, 2012*

Student Travel Awards are available to Graduate Students for participation in the Annual Symposium of the Society of Toxicologic Pathology. Student Travel Award recipients will be selected from the abstracts submitted to the STP. Award selection will be based on the scientific content and impact of the research, and composition and clarity of the abstract.

Each of the students who are chosen will receive a (\$1000) stipend to defray travel, and lodging costs associated with attending the convention, complimentary meeting registration, and complimentary student membership in STP for the following year. Recipients will be honored at an Awards Ceremony prior to the Annual Business Meeting on Wednesday and mentioned in press releases and one or more publications by the STP. All travel award recipients will be required to present a poster at the Symposium during June 24-28, 2012 in Boston. Up to four (4) trainees may be asked to give an additional short (10-20 minute) oral presentation concurrent with the general scientific sessions.

### ***Eligibility***

To be eligible to compete for this award, trainees must be graduate students working in the field of experimental or toxicologic pathology or a related discipline (to include students [veterinary or medical], pathology residents [veterinary or medical] and/or MS or PhD students), and must be available to attend the STP meeting. Candidates who have recently completed (within 12 months of the application date) their graduate studies are also eligible.

2. Ask your faculty advisor or a faculty member who is familiar with your original research work to submit a letter of nomination summarizing your qualifications.
3. Submit your *curriculum vitae*.
4. Include a statement of career goals in toxicologic pathology.
5. Submit an abstract on-line (should be limited to 250 words) describing your original work involving clinical or experimental research that relates to experimental or toxicologic pathology.
