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Registration Information

STP Member, Student, and Nonmember paid registration includes: Scientific sessions (Monday through Thursday), Exhibit Hall access, Exhibitor-sponsored lunch (Monday), Breaks (Monday through Thursday), and one admission to the Welcome Reception (Sunday) and the President's Reception (Wednesday).

Guest registration includes: One admission to both the Welcome Reception (Sunday), the President's Reception (Wednesday), and a half-day tour (for guests registered by April 10, 2016).

Exhibitor registration includes: Scientific sessions (Monday through Thursday), Exhibit Hall access, Exhibitor-sponsored lunch (Monday), Breaks (Monday through Thursday), and one admission to both the Welcome Reception (Sunday) and the President's Reception (Wednesday). Each exhibiting company is permitted two complimentary Exhibitor registrations per rented 8'x10' booth. Additional registrants should register as an Exhibitor Member, Exhibitor Nonmember, or Exhibitor (Scientific Sessions not included).

Exhibitor \$380 registration includes: The Exhibitor Registration fee (\$380) is for companies with more than two exhibitors. This reduced registration does not include admission to the scientific sessions, but does include Exhibit Hall access, Exhibitor-sponsored lunch (Monday), Breaks (Monday through Thursday), and one admission to the Welcome Reception (Sunday) and President's Reception (Wednesday).

One-Day Registration includes: One-Day Registrations are offered Monday through Thursday and include for the day registered: Scientific Sessions, Exhibit Hall access, and Breaks. The Monday fee includes one admission to the Exhibitor-sponsored lunch and Welcome Reception; the Wednesday fee includes one admission to the President's Reception.

Continuing Education Courses and Career Sessions—Registration is Required

NTP Satellite Symposium is free, but registration is required. Wireless keypads (100) will be distributed at the door to registrants on a first-come, first-serve basis.

CE Course—Attendees for half-day paid continuing education courses will receive a link to the digital course syllabus for download prior to the meeting. CE course certificates will be provided at the meeting to those who attend each course following completion. For information about course credit, contact stp@toxpath.org.

Career Sessions—The Career Development Workshop (Sunday AM), Career Lunchtime Series Session (Monday PM), and the IATP Session (Wednesday PM) are open to all registered attendees at no charge, however, registration is required.

Child Attendance Policy

Exhibit Hall: To ensure their safety, registered attendees' children under the age of 18 are not permitted in the Exhibit Hall at any time including during the Exhibits Opening, Regular Hours, Welcome Reception, and Poster Sessions.

Welcome Reception: Registered attendees' children 18 or older must purchase a Welcome Reception ticket to attend the event.

President's Reception: Children **ages 0–11** are permitted to attend the President's Reception at no charge as long as the child is under the supervision of the parent at all times. Children **ages 12–17** may attend the President's Reception if they purchase a reduced cost ticket. They must be under the supervision of the parent at all times. Registered attendees' children **18 or older** must purchase a full price President's Reception ticket to attend.

Scientific Sessions: The STP strongly encourages parents not to bring their children into continuing education courses and scientific sessions. We realize that occasionally it may be necessary to bring young infants to sessions or that older (high school age) children might be interested in a specific scientific topic. If children are brought to scientific sessions, they must be quiet, well mannered, and closely supervised. Parents will be expected to immediately remove a child from any speaker presentation if the child becomes restless, noisy, or disruptive.

Awards Ceremony: The Awards Ceremony is open to all children of registered attendees as long as the child is under the supervision of the parent at all times.

Photography, Videotaping, Recording Policies
